#### Business Management

Studying Business Management means students acquire knowledge and skills equipping them in broad aspects of how organisations function, but allows for specialisation in topics that students are passionate about. Our Business Management outreach sessions offer prospective students an engaging introduction to the diverse career paths within this field.

Future career pathways include:

- Manager, director or executive roles
- Business consultancy
- Growth leadership

## Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship is centred on understanding what makes a great business leader and how to both capture and embrace the enterprising spirit. Students learn what makes an effective entrepreneur through studying both functional aspects such as how to identify opportunities but also the skills and personal attributes it takes to be successful.

Future career pathways include:

## **Marketing**

Students studying marketing will learn the core principles of understanding customers, audiences and stakeholders and the importance of exceeding their expectations. Marketing is a dynamic and evolving subject particularly with digital growth and emergence of new approaches such as influencer marketing.

#### **International Business**

Our International Business sessions provide prospective students with essential insights into the complexities of global business and international management. Students will explore how organisations operate in a globalised world, gaining practical knowledge about navigating diverse markets.

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#### Languages and Culture

Our language courses help students enhance their foreign language skills and deepen cultural awareness. These course's offer valuable insights into global opportunities, including studying, working, and travelling abroad.

# Accounting and Finance

Our accounting and finance course helps students to stand out to employers in the business world by gaining professional accounting qualifications alongside their degree. They will gain an understanding of accounting and finance within the business environment and develop the skills they need for a dynamic career.

#### **Economics**

Our economics courses allow students to engage with the latest economic thinking using real-world issues, quantitative data, statistical packages, and econometric software. #### **Financial Services**

Our financial services courses cover everything from the principles of investment, working with derivatives and managing risk, to Cryptocurrency and Blockchain, with emphasis on their application. We also offer a unique degree in financial trading and investment management which includes a qualification in investment management on top of their degree.

Future career pathways include:



#### **SHU Progress**

SHU Progress provides support for applicants whose personal circumstances might mean that there are barriers to going to university. The scheme provides additional support in the year of application and throughout the application process, including the transition to becoming a university student.

#### How to join

In order to join the scheme, students must be nominated by a professional (such as a teacher, social worker, support worker, etc.) who knows the applicant and their background. You can find the nomination form, as well as further details on eligible groups and the support on offer, by scanning the QR code.
